Professor of psychiatry at Psychiatric Department of the 1st Medical School, Charles University where she has been working since 1986. She started her clinical and academic training at the Department of Epidemiology, Psychiatric Research Institute, Prague. In 1993 - 1995, as a research scientist at Nathan S. Kline Institute, NYU, USA she had been involved in studies of violence and long-term outcome of schizophrenia. Also, she gained experiences as consulting psychiatrist at Emergency Unit in Prague. In the last decades, in the position of the Head of Eating Disorders Center at Psychiatric Department, she developed a Center of Clinical Excellence involved in number of international projects on treatment and prevention of eating disorders (COST B6, Pro-Youth, INTACT, GWAS group), since 1997 organized Czech bi-annual conferences on Eating Disorders and Obesity and participated in organisation of ICED 2017 in Prague. As a member of Academy for Eating disorders since 1997 she represents the Czech Psychiatric Association for Eating Disorders CZEDA in PCAC (Partnership, Chapter and Affiliate Committee). In the Board of Czech Psychiatric Association, she collaborated in pre- and postgradual trainings and Reforme of Psychiatry concept preparation. She has been also active as a training psychoterapist, supervisor in Rafael Institut Prague and Head of E-clinic Prague.
