Graduated from the 3rd Medical Faculty, Charles University in Prague in 2000. He defended his doctoral thesis in Psychiatry – in the field of structural neuroimaging in schizophrenia in 2004 in Masaryk University in Brno. Since 2000 he works as a psychiatrist at the Department of Psychiatry, University Hospital Brno and Faculty of Medicine, Masaryk University in Brno, since 2011 as the head of the department.
