Dr. Theiner is Head of a Child and Adolescent Inpatient Ward of the Department of Psychiatry, University Hospital Brno, Czech Republic.

Dr. Theiner graduated in 2000 at Masaryk University, Brno, Czech Republic and since then he has dedicated his professional life to Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and has worked with hospitalized children and adolescents with a broad spectrum of diagnoses, mostly eating disorders, ADHD and OCD. His PhD thesis in 2006 dealt with genetic correlates of ADHD phenotypes, and biological research in child and adolescent psychiatry has been his research field up to now. He has also an outpatient practice for child and adolescent sexology. In 2009 he finished his CBT training.

Dr. Theiner has organized Czech national congresses in child and adolescent psychiatry since 2000. He is a member of the Czech Psychiatric Society and Czech Neuropsychopharmacological Society. He is a lecturer in psychiatry and Child and adolescent psychiatry at the Masaryk University.
